Dear Parent or Guardian,

Year 11 Options

A great deal of information and advice will be forthcoming from us over the next few weeks to support Your daughter with her decision as to what she will choose to do at the end of Year 11. To help her, and in preparation for this important decision we are planning an information morning on Thursday November 9th for her.

Very broadly speaking, your daughter has three main options at the end of Year 11:

1. Embarking on a three A Level course, either here at Presdales or at another school
2. Embarking on an Apprenticeship with training
3. Starting a vocational course at a Further Education College, usually here in Ware or at Broxbourne or Turnford

The programme on the morning of November 9th will include short 'chat sessions' with the teachers of the new and unfamiliar A Level subjects on offer in our Sixth form. These will include subjects such as Psychology, Sociology, Travel and Tourism, Economics, Government and Politics, Further Maths, Photography, Film or Media.

For those students who do not wish to take A Levels and who would prefer to start an apprenticeship or embark on a vocational course at a local college after Year 11, we have planned talks from speakers for them on those two options here in school.

It would help us very much in our planning if you could discuss with your daughter whether she would prefer to attend the A Level information session or attend the Apprenticeship and College information session on November 9th. Please tell us on the reply slip below which session she has chosen to attend.
